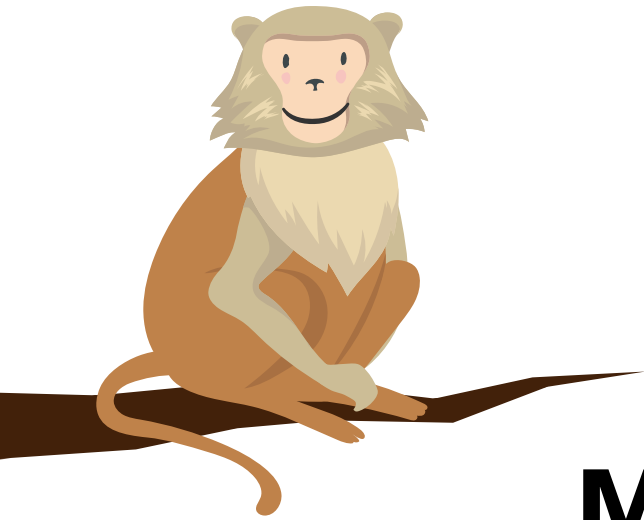

- What do you think you can do tomorrow to make it better than today?

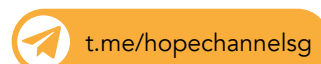
Tip #2 for having great conversations with your child

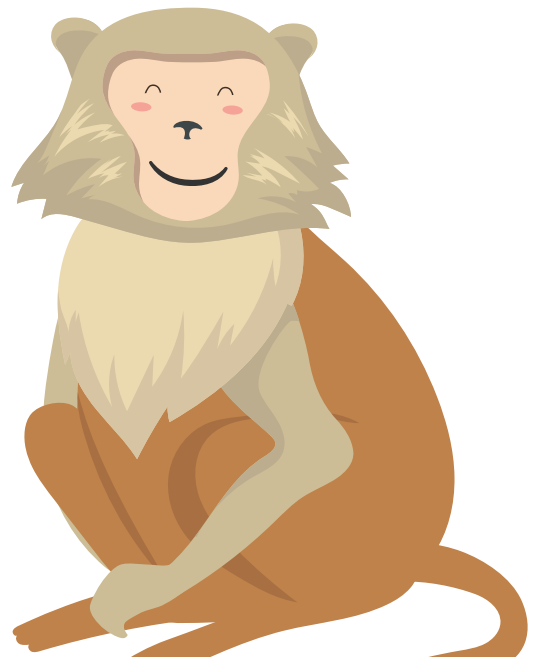
