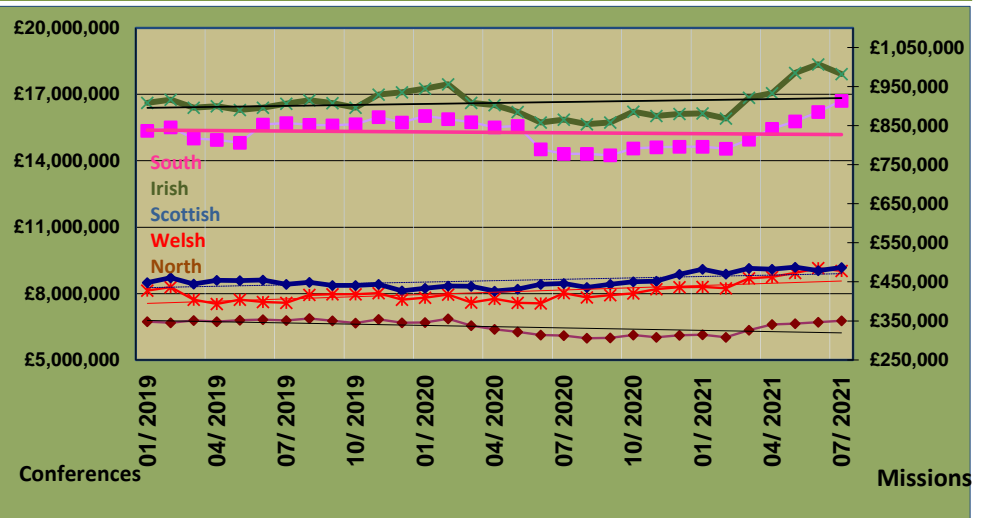
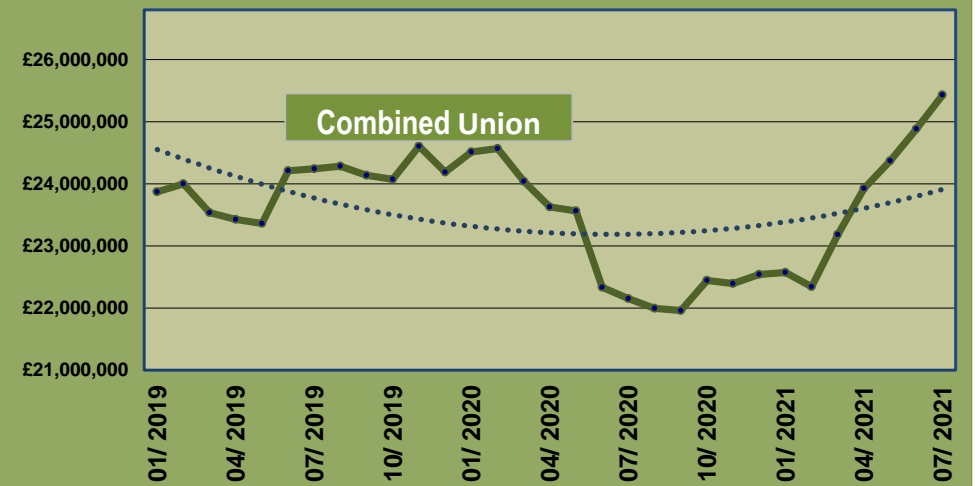

Dear Trustees, as more and more of our churches (covid aware) begin to re-open tithe continues to improve. Comparing July 2019 tithe still reflects a 6.2% increase. BUC July 2021 tithe of £14,593,384 shows a +24.7% increase (£2,888,238) on 2020. Against our budget we are £116,180 (+8.6%) above our 2021 projections. The delayed 2020 Tokyo Paralympics concluded yesterday but was conducted behind mostly closed doors as covid surge in Japan dictated conscious decisions for
