BUC Session 2026: Nine-Month Prayer Plan



This prayer plan is a guide for the nine months leading up to the British Union Conference (BUC) Session in July 2026. It is founded entirely on the core scripture from **Micah 6:8:**

“He has shown you, O mortal, what is good. And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God.”

This scripture provides a powerful and practical framework for our prayers. We will focus our prayers on the three pillars of this verse: Acting Justly, Loving Mercy, and Walking Humbly with God.



Phase 1:

Act Justly

(October – December 2025)

Focus: Seeking righteousness, fairness, and truth in all preparations for the Session and in our church life.

October 2025

Week 1: Give thanks for God's character as a just judge. Pray that the BUC's organizational structures and policies would reflect His righteousness.

Key Scripture: Psalm 11:7

Week 2: Pray for the BUC leadership team to be guided by wisdom and fairness in their decisions, always putting the welfare of the church first.

Key Scripture: Proverbs 8:15

Week 3: Pray for the BUC Executive Committee, asking that they would be unified in pursuing equitable and right solutions for the mission.

Key Scripture: Colossians 3:17

Week 4: Pray for the delegates being chosen for the session, that they would be guided by a spirit of integrity and truth.

Key Scripture: Philippians 4:8

November 2025

Week 1: Pray for all church members to be aware of and committed to a biblical view of justice within their local communities.

Key Scripture: 1 John 3:18

Week 2: Pray for the financial and logistical planning of the session. Ask for complete honesty and good stewardship in every detail.

Key Scripture: Luke 16:10

Week 3: Pray for the reports and motions that will be presented. Ask that they would be a clear and just representation of God's will.

Key Scripture: Isaiah 40:8

Week 4: Pray for a fair and transparent process during the nomination and election of new leaders, free from political maneuvering.

Key Scripture: Deuteronomy 16:19

December 2025

Week 1: Pray for the new leaders to be chosen based on character and competence, not favoritism or personal bias.

Key Scripture: 1 Timothy 3:1–7

Week 2: Pray for an atmosphere of respect and fairness among all delegates, allowing for honest debate and healthy exchange of ideas.

Key Scripture: Galatians 5:13

Week 3: Pray for the families of BUC leaders, that they would be a source of support and encouragement as their loved ones serve.

Key Scripture: Proverbs 14:26

Week 4: Pray for a powerful sense of God's presence as we seek to "act justly" in our church and in the world.

Key Scripture: Micah 6:8a



Phase 2: Love Mercy

(January – March 2026)

Focus: Cultivating compassion, forgiveness, and grace in our interactions, especially during the time of decision-making.

January 2026

Week 1: Pray for a spirit of mercy and compassion to fill the hearts of all BUC members, so we may show grace to one another.

Key Scripture: Romans 12:15

Week 2: Pray for reconciliation and healing for any past hurts or broken relationships within the BUC family.

Key Scripture: 2 Corinthians 5:18–19

Week 3: Pray for the BUC's various ministries, asking that they would be a tangible expression of God's mercy and love to their communities.

Key Scripture: James 2:13

Week 4: Pray for the local churches to be known as centers of kindness, mercy, and support for those who are struggling.

Key Scripture: Ephesians 4:32

February 2026

Week 1: Pray for our mission to the cities of the UK. Ask God to use the BUC to meet the needs of the vulnerable and marginalized.

Key Scripture: Matthew 25:40

Week 2: Pray for the spiritual condition of the country. Ask God to use the BUC to extend His hand of mercy to a hurting nation.

Key Scripture: Joel 2:13

Week 3: Pray for a spirit of loving-kindness and gentleness to prevail over any potential disagreements during the session.

Key Scripture: Ephesians 4:2

Week 4: Pray for the youth and children of the BUC. Ask that they would be nurtured in environments where mercy and grace are taught and practiced.

Key Scripture: Psalm 103:8

March 2026

Week 1: Pray for the well-being of our pastors and their families. Ask God to fill them with the compassion of Christ.

Key Scripture: Matthew 9:36

Week 2: Pray for a renewed commitment to Christian education across all BUC institutions, teaching students the value of loving mercy.

Key Scripture: Colossians 3:12

Week 3: Pray for the delegates to be filled with a spirit of empathy, ready to listen and learn from one another's experiences.

Key Scripture: 1 Peter 3:8

Week 4: Pray for a deeper sense of living out our faith in tangible acts of mercy, just as Jesus did.

Key Scripture: Micah 6:8b



Phase 3: Walk Humbly with God

(April – June 2026)

Focus: Dependence on the Holy Spirit, submission to God's will, and acknowledging that all glory belongs to Him.

April 2026

Week 1: Pray for the Holy Spirit to be poured out upon the BUC. Ask for a spirit of brokenness and repentance that leads to revival.

Key Scripture: 2 Chronicles 7:14

Week 2: Pray for the speakers and presenters at the session. Ask that they would be a clear vessel for God's message, not their own.

Key Scripture: John 3:30

Week 3: Pray for the worship during the session to be a humble and sincere offering to God, free from performance or pride.

Key Scripture: Isaiah 66:2

Week 4: Pray for the session venue and the technology to work seamlessly, so there are no distractions from focusing on God.

Key Scripture: 1 Corinthians 10:31

May 2026

Week 1: Pray for the outcomes of the session. Ask that all decisions would be a result of surrender to God's will, not human compromise.

Key Scripture: Proverbs 3:5–6

Week 2: Pray for the newly elected leaders. Ask God to grant them the wisdom and humility to serve in His strength alone.

Key Scripture: Psalm 101:6

Week 3: Pray for the delegates to take the decisions and inspiration from the session back to their local churches with a spirit of humility and service.

Key Scripture: Matthew 23:12

Week 4: Pray that the Session will be more than just a meeting; may it be a profound spiritual encounter where we all learn to walk more closely with God.

Key Scripture: Colossians 2:6–7

June 2026

Week 1: Pray for a final wave of unity and focus among all involved in the last-minute preparations, with humility as the key characteristic.

Key Scripture: James 4:10

Week 2: Pray for a spirit of reconciliation and healing for any past hurts or disagreements, all done in humility.

Key Scripture: Ephesians 4:2

Week 3: Pray for the Session to be a powerful testimony to the world of a church that is truly walking humbly with its God.

Key Scripture: Matthew 5:16

Week 4: Give all glory and praise to God in advance for what He will accomplish through the BUC Session in July 2026.

Key Scripture: Micah 6:8c
